VITIVULTURE

The vineyards are sited near Cadreita, Villafranca and Caparroso.

The soils lie on alluvial terraces from the Ebro and Aragón rivers. Rich with pebbles and with a thick texture, they offer an excellent drainage. Their chemical composition is also very balanced in terms of a correct distribution of macro and micro elements, and an adequate level of organic matter.

The climate suffers extreme contrasts, with very cold winters and very hot summers, minimum temperatures of -14°C and maximum temperatures of up to 42°C. Rainfall is scarce. The historic average is 380 l/m² per year and falls mainly in spring and autumn.

WINEMAKING

The grapes macerate at a low temperature for a few hours and then the must bleeds and ferments at 14°C. The wine is bottled after a soft clarification.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Yellow, with greenish reflexes. Very bright.

Nose: Aromas of white flowers and citric fruits.

Palate: Fresh, fruity and pleasant on the palate. Round and balanced.
